Catering service for Emergency Events	DELWP has identified a business requirement to engage contractors for the supply of catering services at Emergency Incidents, Firefighters, Incidents Management team (IMT), Base Camp support personnel and any other visitors to the camp, who will need to receive healthy and nutritious meals. DELWP are seeking contractors who are able to provide a specific catering service at short notice. Contractors will be asked to nominate areas for service across Victoria where they can be deployed. Contractors will be given as much notice as possible and will be required to be deployed within 12 hours of engagement and serving the first meals within 24 hours, unless otherwise agreed to.	The Department will provide a mobile kitchen and support unit in readiness for the contractor's use. At times the Department may use local catering facilities available, such as sporting ground facilities. These services are generally required during fire season (November through April) and although less likely, possibly during other times of the year for the planned burning program or other emergencies eg. floods. Catering for 100 people will be a minimum requirement, but could be as high as 1000 people per day depending on Operational activity. Contractors could be placed on standby, in specific areas, during extreme fire danger days. Being placed on standby will require resources to be on the road to the advised set up location within twenty minutes of being contacted to cater for no less than 100 people. A Base Camp usually contain catering and accommodation facilities which may include both daytime and night time sleeping arrangements.
